Birthday Celebrations



On Monday 24 May Ms Knezevic, Isabel Mrsic (School Leader) and her grandparents attended the Mass for 200 years of Catholic Education in Australia at St Patrick's Cathedral in Parramatta. Before the Mass, the event began with a moving Welcome to Country and Smoking Ceremony from Darug Elders Aunty Julie Webb and Uncle Lex Dadd. The Mass featured student musicians, and a moving performance of Ave Maria. Bishop Vincent reflected on Diocesan Patroness St Mary of the Cross MacKillop's exhortation, "never see a need without doing something about it".

CEDP Executive Director Greg Whitby also spoke about the legacy of St Mary of the Cross MacKillop, "a woman whose extraordinary faith effectively extended the opportunities of education to ordinary Australian children". He presented Bishop Vincent with the painting about Parramatta's history by Darug Artist Leanne Tobin. Each school received a plaque to honour the occasion as part of the event.
